Travel to Port Douglas via the Captain Cook Highway, one of Australia's most scenic coastal drives.

The Wildlife Habitat

Arrive at The Wildlife Habitat. Join a guided tour and see the endangered cassowary and other wildlife, with the opportunity to have your photo taken holding a koala, snake or crocodile (extra cost). Breakfast or snacks available for purchase.

Daintree River

Next, you will travel to the Daintree River Cruise Centre and embark on a Daintree River Cruise to spot crocodiles, birds and other wildlife as you journey through the mangroves. Arrive at the other side of the Daintree River and travel along the rainforest-fringed Cape Tribulation Road through Daintree National Park, a magnificent wilderness region, as your guide explains the area's history.

Road Home

You'll see magnificent views from Alexandra Lookout and stop at Floravilla Art Gallery and Ice Cream Factory for a picnic lunch.

Then stretch your legs at Dubuji Boardwalk with a guided rainforest and beach walk that's filled with great photo opportunities. Depart Cape Tribulation for return journey.
